

Carbon County, WY

Reclaimed Asphalt Pavement (RAP)

Problem Statement:

Lack of availability and cost of new crushed gravel for road surfacing often hinders efforts to keep gravel surfaced roads in top shape.

Solution:

An ample supply of RAP was available from the Wyoming DOT at a cost of \$1.83 per ton (\$2.02 per metric ton). Crushed gravel in the same area was costing between \$5.00 and \$6.50 per ton (\$5.50 and \$7.20 per metric ton). Based on analysis of two locations, RAP has proven to be a very cost effective surfacing for local roads.
