Utilization of Wood Chips

Problem Statement:

Removal of trees from highway right-of-way is cumbersome and often does not get done. If timber is "chipped" the disposal is another concern. Another unrelated problem is unwanted vegetation growth under guardrail and around signs and mail boxes.

Solution:

A wood chipper was purchased and timber "chipped" onsite. The chips are then placed under guardrail and around sign supports and mail boxes to limit unwanted vegetation growth. The result is a uniform, aesthetically pleasing area.
